Please read the following information thoroughly!

*All applicants must be a minimum of age 14 by July 24, 2011 and/or at least a rising 9th grader for fall 2011.

Tech Interns must be available for workshop duties at Durham School of the Arts for the following times:

- 1). Saturday, July 23, 2011 at 9:00am, for load in and set up.
- 2). Sunday July 24, 2011 thru Friday July 29, 2011, from approx. 8am thru 9pm
- 3). Saturday, July 30, 2011, from 8am thru the conclusion, strike and load out of the 4:00pm finale concert (approximately 9pm).

* Please note: Final work times will be scheduled by the tech directors. During the week, shifts will be used when possible.

Duties of tech interns:

- Load in and strike for the workshop week
- Moving and setting up risers, sound and light equipment
- Manning sound and light board during rehearsals
- Helping with rehearsal room needs, as they arise
- Troubleshooting tech issues
- Building props
- Assisting tech directors and camp staff as needed
- Running performances in a position such as those listed below:
 1. Sound operator
 2. Lightboard operator
 3. Assistant stage manager
 4. Prop master
 5. Followspot operator
- In general helping to make camp week a success

Please note that this tech intern position is as a volunteer. However lunches and dinners during times on campus will be provided free of charge. We also hope/know that the experience you get will be invaluable!
